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How much you can make from placing articles and affiliate links on your website differs from person to person. How much you are able to make will depend mostly on how successful your site is. This means getting good search engine rankings through SEO efforts, making your site enjoyable and informative to read through engaging content, building your site around a great niche subject, how big your site is, and how many sites you have.

Some people claim to make as much as \$10,000 per month (\$120,000 per year) through building and promoting niche sites. However, most people should not expect this kind of success, especially if you are very new, as that kind of success usually only comes with experience and acquired skill. A reasonable income to expect from a niche site, after you have worked for months to gain traffic and are hooked up with good affiliates, may be \$500-\$1,000 per month. However this is recurring income, so you will make that much monthly off of the efforts you put into that one site. It is not a one-shot payment.

After you have a successful site, most choose to continue to build niche sites. The more sites that you build, the better an income you can generate. Some also choose to build very fast and very short sites over sites that are slightly longer in length. It should be noted that the larger each of your sites are, the more income you will likely generate off of them.

When starting out, it is important to remember that your first site will always be your hardest, since you are just learning the ropes of the business and that not everyone is cut out to market and promote niche sites. It may not work out for you and you may end up losing a little bit of money but that is a risk that everyone in this business has to take.

The important thing is that you don't give up without a good shot at it, if this is really what you want to do. Your first site may take a long time, the work may be tedious, and you may feel like throwing in the towel. However, if you give up too early, you will never know what could have been. Who knows, you may be the next big website entrepreneur!

Steps to AdSense Domination

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When you make your living online, you realize the need for multiple streams of income. One of the easiest and most lucrative ways to generate a secondary income, which also happens to be passive, is via Google's AdSense program. I'm sure you've read the claims of a few individuals generating five figure monthly incomes from AdSense. For many of you, I'm sure you are wondering why you aren't making this same income yourself.

Step 1 — Preparation

today.

Step 2 - Determine Your Markets

In order to maximize AdSense income with only twenty-four sites, you must know which markets are paying well. To break this down even further, you need to know which keywords within those markets are paying the most.

Step 3 - Register you domains

Once you've identified and chosen your markets, you must register domains appropriate to those markets. For example, if your market is "Cabbage Patch Dolls" a domain such as "www.cabbage-patch-doll.com" would be appropriate.

Step 4 - Create your site

Using your favorite page generation software and keyword list, it's time to develop your site. There are several key points to bear in mind when you develop these specifically for AdSense.

- 1. Format Always use the largest ads
- 2. Border Match the same color as your background.
- 3. Link Color = "0000CC"
- 4. URL Color = "999999"
- 5. Text Color = "333333"
- 6. Position Far left or center and just above the page fold (Top 25% of site)

Step 5 - Verify and track your site

Visit your site and make sure all links work and that the sites appear to your satisfaction. You should also check out the ads Google is displaying. Are they targeted to your primary high paying keyword? If not, recreate your site using your high paying keyword in a higher density throughout your site. Make sure you track your AdSense format, position, and traffic with a tracking system specifically designed for AdSense. Once you know your stats, you can adjust for maximum click-throughs and higher revenues.

Step 6 — Get your site listed in the search engines

This is simple… no tricks involved. Simply post links to your site.

I've simplified the process here but you are now armed with enough information and resources to make some serious money with AdSense.
